

Fire Safety Rules and Rules for the Use of Electrical Appliances for guests staying at Azhur^{SH} Suzdal Hotel.

- All guests staying at the hotel, campground, or motel must familiarize themselves with and acknowledge their understanding of the fire safety rules and rules for using electrical appliances (by signing).
2. Guests must familiarize themselves with the evacuation diagrams in case of fire, the locations of emergency exits, firefighting equipment, and fire alarm buttons.
 3. The following is prohibited in the hotel and restaurant building:
 - storage and use of flammable liquids and substances, explosive materials, gas cylinders, and other hazardous and combustible substances and materials;
 - use of open flames;
 - smoking, except in designated smoking areas;
 - leaving children unattended;
 - leaving pets unattended;
 - blocking entrance doors, balcony and loggia doors, passages to adjacent rooms, and evacuation exits with furniture, equipment, and other items;
 - using fireworks and other pyrotechnic products.
 4. On the surrounding premises, the following is prohibited:
 - making fires and using open flames, except in specially equipped and designated areas;
 - using fireworks and other pyrotechnic products.
 5. The electrical outlets in the hotel use alternating current with a voltage of 220 volts.
 6. When operating electrical installations, the following is prohibited:
 - using electrical appliances in conditions that do not comply with the requirements of the manufacturer's instructions or using appliances that have malfunctions that, according to the operating instructions, can cause a fire. It is also prohibited to use electrical wires and cables with damaged or non-protective insulation;
 - using damaged sockets, switches, and other electrical installation devices.
 - wrapping or covering light bulbs and lamps with paper, fabric, and other flammable materials, as well as using lamps without lamp shades (diffusers) provided for by the design of the lamp;
 - using irons, hot plates, electric kettles, and other electric heating appliances that do not have thermal protection devices, or non-combustible heat-insulating stands that prevent the risk of fire.
 - connecting multiple appliances to a single socket using a multi-plug adapter with 3-4 outlets;
 - leaving connected electrical appliances unattended, placing them near combustible objects and materials.
 7. In case of detecting strong heating of an electrical plug, device, or socket, immediately switch off the electrical appliance.
 8. In case of discovering a fire or signs of burning (smoke, burning smell, increase in temperature):
 - immediately report it by phone to the fire department (indicate the address, the fire origin, and your surname);
 - implement appropriate measures for the safe evacuation of individuals, fire suppression, and protection of valuable materials.
